## Open Market Vendor Agreement

The Village of Argyle would like to invite area vendors to participate in Argyle's **ELEVENTH** Open Market Season. Market Days are scheduled rain or shine and will rarely be cancelled. If the weather is questionable, use your own judgement as to whether or not you choose to participate. This year the market will run from 9 am – 12:30 pm on the first and third Saturdays from June through October with the EXCEPTION of the October 15<sup>th</sup> market. The October 15<sup>th</sup> market will run from 11-4 and be held at the American Legion Park in conjunction with the Chili Cook Off/ Fall Festival sponsored by the Argyle Park Committee. The market is supported by the Village of Argyle; vendors are not charged a fee. There will not be electricity or a dumpster available for vendor use. New vendors are always welcome.

**Location:** the old high school lots on the corner of Hwy 81 (Monroe St.) and Broad St.

**Time:** 9:00 am – 12:30 pm. Set-up is from 8-9 am.

**VENDORS MUST STAY UNTIL 12:30 PM, NO EARLY PULL OUTS!**

**Returning and new vendors are required to fill out this Vendor Agreement Form *BEFORE* setting up.**

There will be another prize drawing this year on July 2. Prizes can be anything you choose with a dollar amount of your choice. I'll make up certificates to mail to the winners. Winners will either bring the certificate to a future market or make arrangements with vendors to redeem at another time. Are you willing to donate a prize? **YES NO**

## Rules & Regulations:

**Participants** are responsible for everything needed for set-up and clean-up of space reserved, including change and monies for sales. Any vendor using a canopy will weight each corner with a minimum of 20 lbs.

**Participants** will be assigned a space when they arrive. Spaces are on a first come basis.

**Participants** will move their vehicles away from the vending area after unloading. Vendors are not allowed to drive/park in the lot (with the exception of the American Legion for the July 2 market).

**Participants** will message Argyle Open Market via Facebook by 9 pm or call the Community building (608-543-3113) before 4 pm the Friday prior to market day if you're unable to attend.

**All Participants** fully release and forever discharge the Village of Argyle, its employees and volunteers from any and all claims for injuries and/or damages or loss that may occur.

**Participants** will stay home if they are ill or not feeling well..

**The Village of Argyle** reserves the right to deny any vendor.
